



Americold Contributes to Haitian Relief Efforts

On Tuesday, January 12th, an earthquake measuring 7.0 on the Richter scale hit the heart of Haiti, the capital Port-au-Prince, knocking down buildings, homes, and power lines and adding to the suffering of the Haitian people. The earthquake that struck shortly before 5 P.M. was the most powerful to hit Haiti in a century and was centered about 10 miles southwest of Port-au-Prince.

The American Red Cross is working with its partners in the global Red Cross and Red Crescent network, including the Haitian Red Cross, and other partners to assist those affected by this disaster. Americold has donated \$10,000 to the American Red Cross to assist in the relief effort. Americold's donation will help the American Red Cross in deploying personnel, sending relief supplies, and providing financial resources for the victims of the earthquake.
